- ⇒ The person will be more autonomous and much less fearful of their situation and the amount of documentation required. They can now take care of herself.
- ⇒ Finally that person can receive what they are entitled to based on relevant laws or regulations

Service offered

- ⇒ Informations on laws and regulations on assistance to individuals and families.
- ⇒ Help to complete forms and documents
- ⇒ Information on rights, obligations, and deadlines
- ⇒ Assistance in preparing your file, for administrative or medical review request.
- ⇒ Assistance in the steps to be taken to complain to CNESST (Labour Standards)
- ⇒ Possibility of accompaniment and / or representation in the administrative court and or even media.

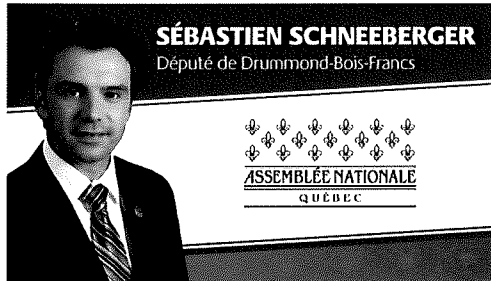

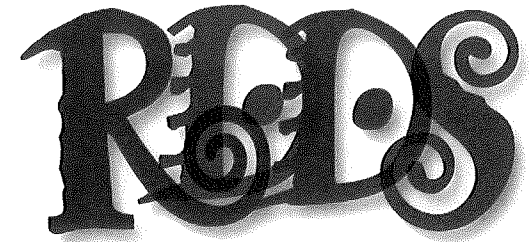
